Aug. 24 (Sat) ~ Sep. 8 (Sun)

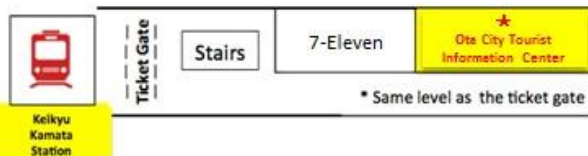
